Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.

People have been asking me what I think of the new pope. Well, the first time I ever heard the name Robert Prevost was in the days leading up to the conclave. A citizen of the United States. No chance. To say I was shocked is an understatement.

My only "experience" of him was his being introduced to Rome and to the world from the balcony in Saint Peter's Square after his election. I told people to look for a couple of things: what name he chooses and his first words. They are powerful: "Peace be with all of you!" In the text of his greeting, here are the important things I think will tell us of the clues and direction of his ministry.

"...an unarmed peace and a disarming peace, humble and persevering. It comes from God, God who loves us all unconditionally."

"God loves us, God loves you all, and evil will not prevail! We are all in the hands of God. Therefore, without fear, united hand in hand with God and among ourselves, we move forward."

"We are disciples of Christ. Christ precedes us. The world needs his light. Humanity needs him as the bridge that allows us to reach God and his love. Help us, too, and help each other to build bridges, with dialogue and encounter, uniting us all to be one people, always in peace."

"...to walk together with you...to work as men and women who are faithful to Jesus Christ, without fear, to proclaim the Gospel, to be missionaries...we must seek together how to be a missionary Church, a Church that builds bridges, always open to receive..."

Today I want to give a shoutout to our graduates. Some may have already graduated from college or graduate school. In the days ahead we will celebrate commencement exercises for our students in pre-school and kindergarten, and of course high school. It is a happy occasion for the graduates and for their families who are proud of the achievement of their children.

Well done students! Well done families! Well done teachers! As my friend Deacon Dennis Duff would say: "Hey, I talked to God today, and he said you done good!"

Learn About the Mission Trip to El Salvador


Veronica Mangrich of Newton is coming to tell us about the recent mission trip to El Salvador.


