



Join us for the Pacem in Terris Award Peace and Freedom Award on July 9th at 7pm! All are also welcome to attend Mass at 5:30pm and refreshments at 6:30pm. The award will be presented by Bishop Walsh.

Bishop Báez, who lives in exile in the United States, has risked his life advo-

cating for justice and peace in his beloved homeland of Nicaragua. He is among hundreds of Nicaraguans expelled or deported in recent years for criticizing the administration of President Daniel Ortega and his wife, Vice President Rosario Murillo.

Bishop Báez speaks prophetically against the government in his home country because the resulting oppression affects the lives of his people and perpetuates a multitude of injustices. He has been a shepherd of the poor and a courageous defender of human rights and democracy. Bishop Báez currently serves as Professor of Scripture on the faculty of St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary, Boynton Beach, USA.
