

## Something to think about...

Pope: 'Hunger must not be used as an weapon of war' Pope Leo XIV sends a message to the 44th session of the FAO Conference, and condemns the use of hunger as a weapon of war and expenditures on arms production instead of eradicating poverty.

In his message, the Pope said the Church supports all efforts to end the "scandal of global hunger," recalling Jesus' care to feed the crowds who had come to hear Him speak. "We realize that the true miracle accomplished by Christ was to show that the key to defeating hunger lies more in sharing than in greedily hoarding," he said.

"We are now witnessing, with deep sorrow, the inhumane use of hunger as a weapon of war," said the Pope. "Starving civilian populations is a very cheap way to wage war." Read the full article -
