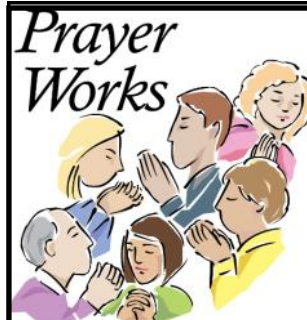

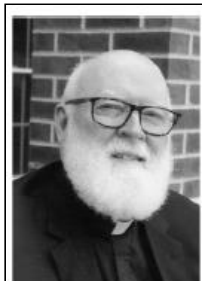

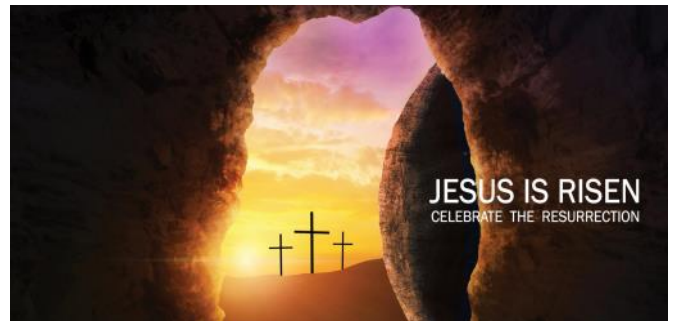

Prayer for Vocations Diocese of Davenport Vocations Prayer

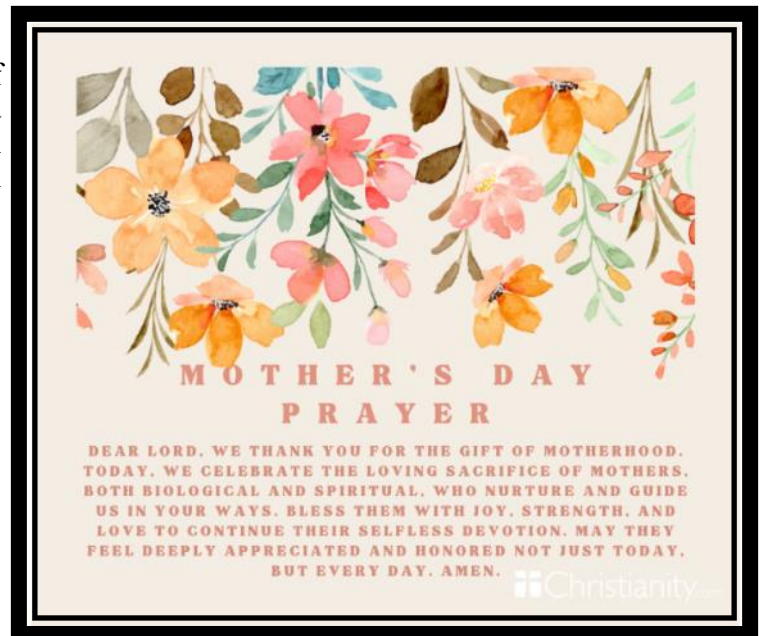
Almighty God, you created us to share in your Divine Life.
