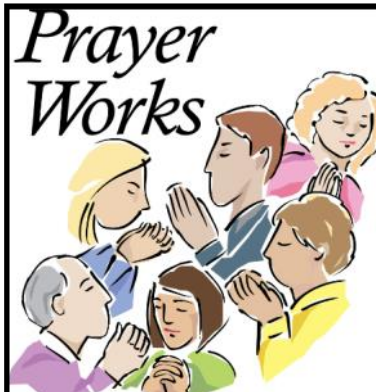

There will be a second collection for Food For Kids Summer Backpack program on Sunday, July 12.

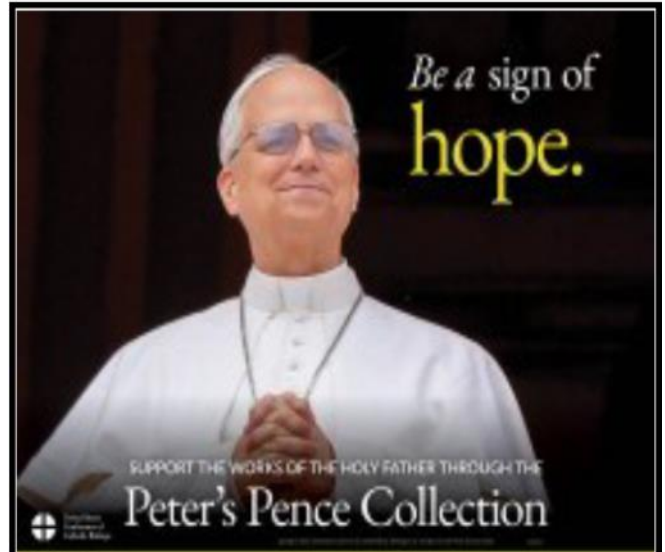

Backpack Summer Program

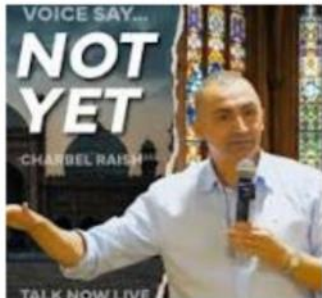
